Intercultural and social cohesion (social competence)

- ability to help to enhance mutual understanding
- ability to develop group building and belonging

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#### Short description of the lesson:

- Students will learn to use the vocabulary they have and interact with the group
- The method can be used in the language class or in the vocational class depending on what needs to be practiced; writing, speaking, vocabulary or vocational context
- The method can also be used for a part of the group, while teaching something else for others, or with faster students, while they're waiting, or as a break activity

#### Equipment needed:

- pictures that form a story (can be anything, for example a cartoon or vocational subject related story; see example pictures)
- pen and paper for writing if needed

### How to use:

- explain the idea to students
- one student/ or group of students get the pictures of one story
- the student/students will organize the pictures in order to form a rational story and talk with each other about what happens in the pictures
- the student/students will tell the story to other students
- students can also write the stories
- at the end: others can also tell what they think happens in the pictures, talk with the students about what they learned, what is in the pictures, etc.
